The policy as a whole considers learning identified through the <u>Manchester Safeguarding</u> <u>Partnership</u> and <u>Community safety</u> <u>Partnership</u> These themes include:

- Complex Self Neglect
- Exploitation
- Cultural awareness
- Carers and co-dependency
- Issues Regarding engagement
- Application of the MCA (2005)
- Collaborative working
- Confidence leading on S42 Enquiries

Part one provides information regarding our legal duties and core legislative frameworks including <u>Care Act (2014)</u> Eligibility & Manchester's corporate safeguarding standards. It is written with

consideration of the <u>6</u> <u>Safeguarding principles</u> and the <u>Making</u>

Safeguarding Personal

agenda. It also provides information on roles and responsibilities and information sharing.

Part 2 addresses the 4 stages of adult safeguarding:

- Stage 1: Identifying a safeguarding concern
 Stage 2: Section 42
- safeguarding enquiry
- Stage 3: Safeguarding plan and review
- Stage 4: Closing the safeguarding enquiry

It also provides indicative timescales and guidance around Organisational Abuse (complex/large scale enquiries)

Part 3 provides a series of templates and checklists for the practitioner.
